MELBOURNE group Pot Pourri took an enthusiastic audience on a musical journey to legendary Broadway during a performance at Mandurah Performing Arts Centre on Thursday night.

Sopranos Tania de Jong and Rebecca Bode, tenor Jon Bode, baritone Jonathan Morton and pianist Rebecca Chambers presented a glittering evening of popular opera, musical theatre and song.

Witty repartee linked the numbers and there was a strong element of audience interaction throughout the program, which was presented with polish and pizzazz.

Chambers' fingers danced across the piano keys in a solo that showcased her virtuosity, slipping effortlessly from classical passion to the romance of light opera and the spirit of jazz.
